Nature and Extent of involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/ improvements

For every class, a Class Committee has been formed. The Class Committee is headed by a Senior Faculty member who do not handle the class. Six students' representatives (both boys and girls) are the members of the Committee along with the faculty members handling the classes. The Committee meets once in a semester. The grievances of the students, if any, are taken up to the HoD concerned who in turn discuss with the Principal. Necessary remedial measures are taken.

Mechanism / Norms and Procedure for democratic / good Governance

Mechanism / Norms:

Principal is given full freedom by the Management for the smooth functioning of the college. He is overall administrative in-charge of the college. Under him, the academic and administrative wings work. The Heads of Department look after the academic side under whom teaching and non-teaching staff work. Class Committees are formed with the teaching staff as the Class Counsellor. They represent their grievances through the Class Counsellor.

Student Feedback:

Institutional grievance and faculty performance are assessed through appraisal form obtained from the students. Feedbacks from the students are obtained once in every semester through the appraisal forms and necessary corrective measures taken.

Grievances Redressal Mechanism:

Grievances Redressal Committee, which is headed by the Principal, has been formed. The Committee consists of 18 members representing faculty staff and students. The Committee meets as and when required. The grievances such as staff promotion, pay fixation, leave, etc., are discussed and remedial measures are taken. Grievances from students side such as lack of amenities, extension of time for fee payment, etc., are discussed. The decisions of the Grievance Committee meeting are taken up by the Principal to the management for speedy implementation.
